The German Model

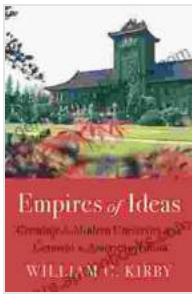

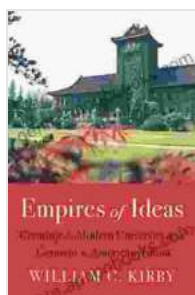
