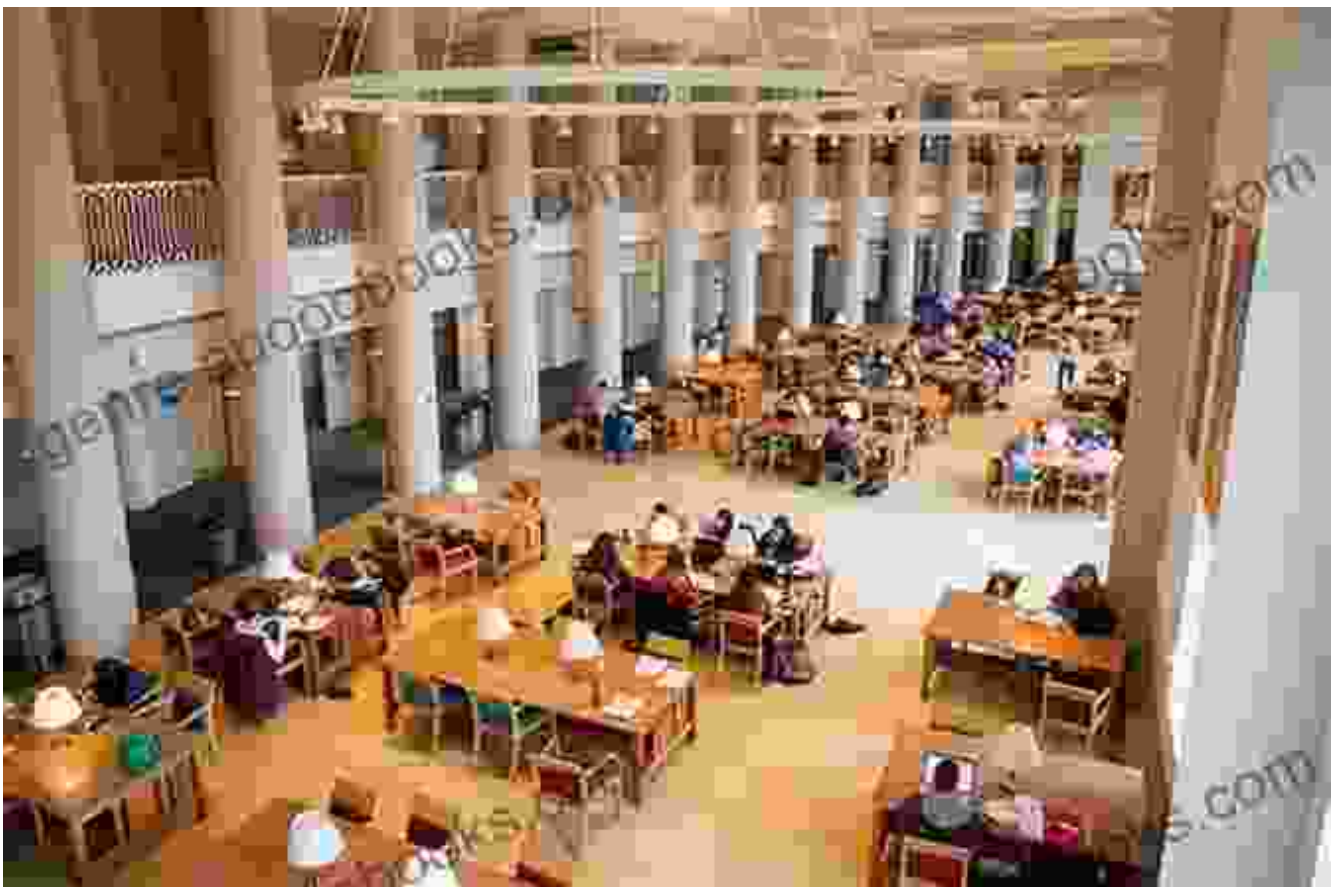

The library is open to the public Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

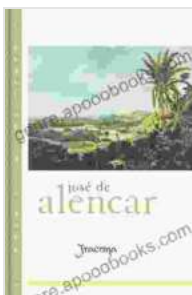
